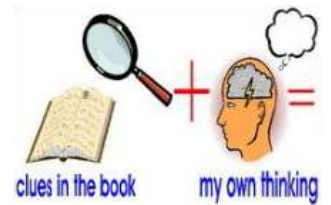


Week 3 Day 4 – Reading – Greta and the Giants
