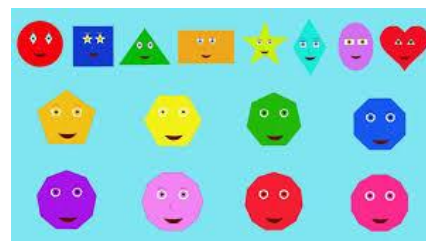
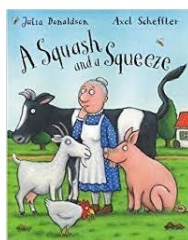
Look at [a squash and a squeeze](#) can you name the animals with your child. Below are a few ideas about what you could talk about:
