

## Adding Money – Help Sheet

### Example with NO exchange

$£3 \text{ and } 24\text{p} + £1 \text{ and } 12\text{p} =$

Step 1 – Write the first amount using place value counters.

Step 2 – Write the second amount underneath using place value counters.

Step 3 – Write the total starting with the ones column first.

Step 4 – Convert your number into pounds and pence. Remember 100p is the same as £1.

436p which is £4 and 36p.

### Example with an exchange

$£2 \text{ and } 75\text{p} + £2 \text{ and } 50\text{p} =$

Step 1 – Write the first amount using place value counters.

Step 2 – Write the second amount underneath using place value counters.

Step 3 – Write the total for the ones column.

Step 4 – Notice here when I write the total I have 12 tens. It's impossible to have more than 9 tens in this column so I need to exchange 10 tens which is the same as 100. (Cross out 10 tens and replace it with one hundred)

Step 5 – Convert your number into pounds and pence. Remember 100p is the same as £1.

525p which is £5 and 25p
