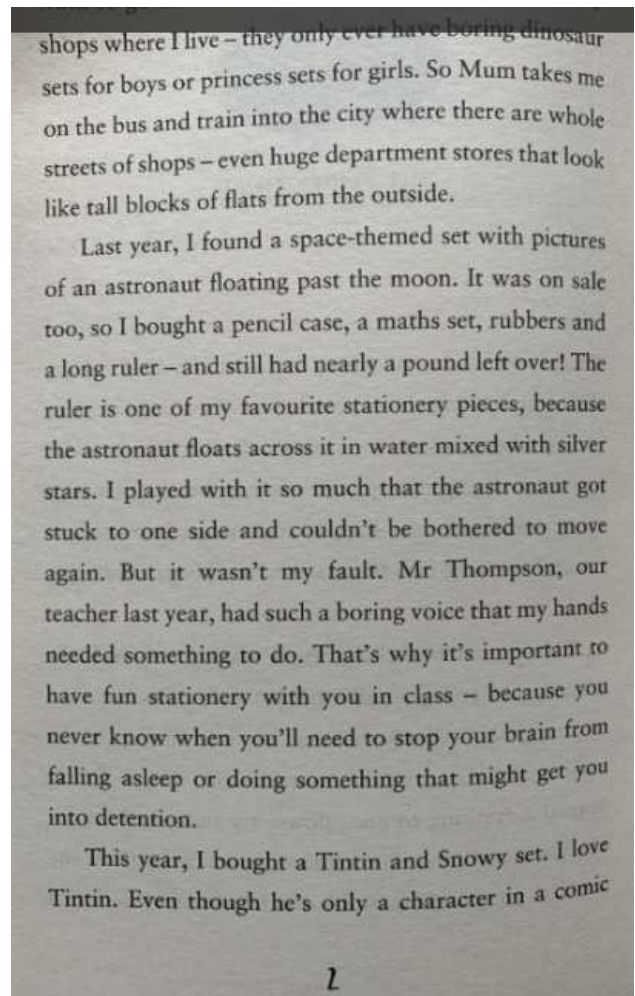
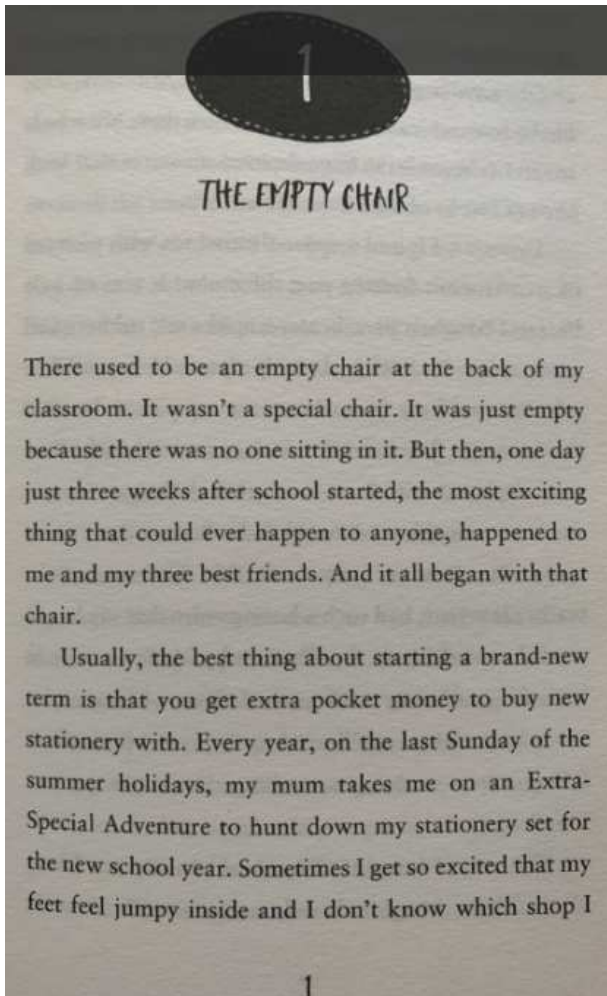


Week 8 Day 3 - English – Using the Possessive Apostrophes for Singular and Plural Nouns.

Plural nouns	Apostrophe for possession	Sentence
classrooms	classrooms'	After the school had been flooded, the classrooms' walls needed repainting.
