English (Reading)

Try to spend 20-30 minutes a day reading. Here are our KS2 Reading Skills to help you when you are reading.


This week, we are focusing on the reading skills, summarise and predict and retrieval.

- Week 10 Day 1 Read the next two pages of our class text and find the meaning of four words you are unsure about. PDF.
- Week 10 Day 2 Today, we are focusing on summarising information from the text. Reread the story and order the events in which they happened. PDF.
- Week 10 Day 3 Today, we are focusing on predicting. Reread page 17 and use the language structures to help you predict what you think is going to happen next.
- Week 10 Day 4 Complete the retrieval questions using all of the strategies you know. PDF.
- Week 10 Day 5 Let's enjoy the fifth chapter of Harry Potter and the Philosopher's stone called 'Diagon Alley' read by Simon Callow, Bonnie Wright and Evanna Lynch. You will need to register (for free) on the website to listen to the audiobook.

Mathematics

Using the Oaks National Academy resources, you are able to access daily sessions to support learning from home.

This week, we are going to focus on one of Miss Ayton's favourite topics in Year 4 – Coordinates!



- Week 10 Day 1 -Describe positions on a 2D grid as coordinates.
- Week 10 Day 2 -Investigate a problem describing positions on a 2D grid as coordinates.
- Week 10 Day 3 -Plot specified points and draw sides to complete a given triangle.
- Week 10 Day 4 -Describe movements between positions as translations of a given unit to the left/right or up /down.
- Week 10 Day 5 -Complete 20 minutes on TT Rockstars, including two sound checks. Miss Ayton has set a class battle. Last week, it was very close between the classes. Which class will win this week?



English (Writing)

This week, we will be recapping how to use direct speech correctly in our writing.



- Week 10 Day 1 In this lesson, remind yourself about the key rules for using speech. Watch this <u>clip</u> and then convert the speech bubbles into <u>direct speech</u>. Remember, we call speech marks, inverted commas.
- Week 10 Day 2 In this lesson, you will focus on using alternative words for said when writing direct speech. Watch this <u>clip</u> to help you and then find words to replace said in the <u>sentences</u>. PDF.
- Week 10 Day 3 In this lesson, you will focus on using adverbs to describe how someone is talking. Watch this <u>slideshow</u> to see some examples of using adverbs to describe how someone is talking and rewrite these <u>sentences</u> using inverted commas, alternative words for said and adverbs to describe how the speaker is talking.
- Week 10 Day 4 In this lesson, you will use your knowledge of writing <u>direct</u> <u>speech</u>, using alternative words for said and adverbs to show how the person is talking. <u>PowerPoint</u>.
