



Home School Agreement

To support phased re-opening of schools

By working together, we can support everyone in finding a way forwards and staying safe.



The school will :

- * Support children's social and emotional needs as they return to the school environment.
- * Keep group sizes small
- * Make sure children wash their hands regularly and thoroughly
- * Arrange the learning environment and provide individual resources to reduce risk and promote social distancing
- * Alter the school day and arrangements to promote social distancing and reduce risk
- * Keep parents informed of changes to routines and arrangements

However, it is not possible for:

- Teachers to be with all of their own class
- Classes to be in their own classroom
- Teach 'normal lessons'

It's going to be different

Parents must:

- * Respect the decisions made by school and understand that the safety and welfare of children and staff must come first
- * Arrive at the designated time to drop off and collect children in the designated places. You cannot come in late.
- * Contact the office by telephone or email, not in person
- * Make sure children wear clean clothes everyday
- * Maintain social distancing AT ALL TIMES to minimise the risk to everyone

However, it is not possible for:

- Parents/carers to meet face-to-face with staff
- Parents/carers to go to the school office in person
- Parents/carers to wait on the playground

Signature of parent to accept this agreement:

The children must :

- * Follow social distancing rules in school and out of school
- * Stay in their seat unless told by their adult
- * Wash their hands regularly and thoroughly
- * Maintain social distancing on the playground
- * Remember to use tissue when sneezing or coughing
- * Not bring any items into school, including bags - coats only if necessary.
- * Keep long hair tied back on no jewellery allowed

However, it is not possible for:

- All children to have their own teacher
- All children to be in their own classroom
- Children to play with their friends



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By working together, we can support everyone in finding a way forwards and staying safe.



- ◇ During this period of phased reopening, we will be reviewing all procedures constantly to ensure that we are doing our best to keep everyone safe and protected.
- ◇ We will continue to provide home learning plans for children who are not attending school.
- ◇ Parents/Carers will not be penalised for not sending children back to school but the advice is that children should be coming back.
- ◇ We will be offering a limited school meal service to all children who are eligible for free school meals and universal free school meals. No hot meals will be available.
- ◇ Any Key Stage 2 children who bring lunch from home must use a plastic/paper bag which will be disposed of after lunch.
- ◇ Social distancing is vital and we will do our best to maintain it in school, parents/carers should ensure they are continuing to follow the most up-to-date guidance on social distancing out of school.
- ◇ If you do not feel that you or your children will be able to follow the expectations set out in this agreement, please let us know as this will increase the risk to other children and staff which must be avoided.
- ◇ If children are unable to be safe and keep others safe, parents will be contacted and may need to collect them from school.
