


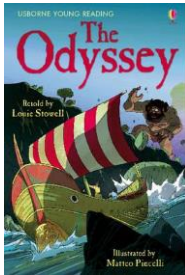
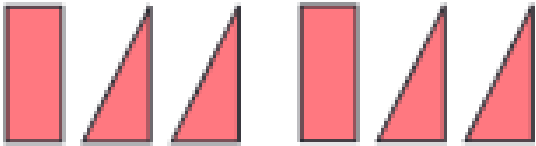

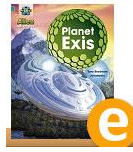

Read a book from the many choices.



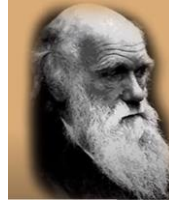
Play a game and read a book using familiar sounds.

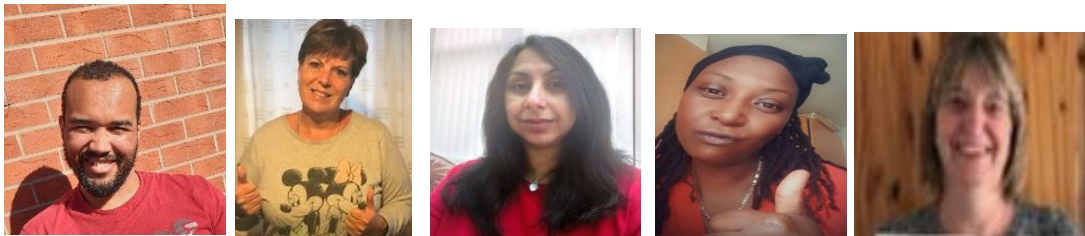
