- What makes a good friend? Think of some words to describe your friends from nursery, you could even have a go at writing the words with help from a grown up. How about drawing a picture of your friend/s to go with your work?

- Have a go at a science experiment using [skittles](http://www.skittles.com). Talk about the different coloured sweets, think about what might happen and then carry out the experiment telling a grown up what happened. Parents please share what your child says on teams.












- See if you can find some seeds and talk about what you think it might grow into. Think about what plants need in order to grow and then have a go at planting your own and follow the journey as it grows. Fruit can be a great place to find some seeds.

- As we have been talking about our friends, both at nursery and at home, have a go at making a friendship bracelet to give to someone you care about. There are lots of different design ideas on google, you could even add some beads.
