For Nursery age children please find the following links for extra activities you can try at home.



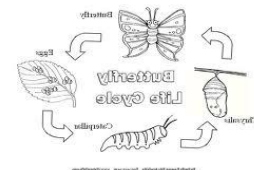
Try some fun activities from the [tts exciting learning opportunities booklet](#). It provides a range of activities for you to try at home suitable for children in EYFS.

- Draw a lifecycle of a butterfly, you can use the story 'The very hungry caterpillar' to help you. Try to include some labels to your drawing to show the egg, caterpillar, cocoon (chrysalis) and butterfly.



- Practise writing your name, ask a grown up to write your name at the top of the page and see if you can copy the letters. If you can write your first name why not try writing your surname.

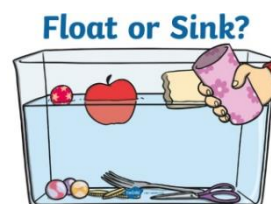
- Once you have completed the one less activity for this week, how about trying to add one more and see what number it makes. You could even try to represent one more and less like in the image here.



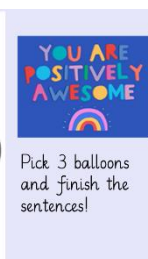
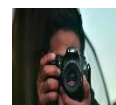


- Have a go at making your own playdough, following this recipe.  
2 cups flour  
1 cup salt  
1 cup water  
Mix ingredients altogether, you can add paint or food colouring to make coloured dough. Don't forget to share a picture of your creations with us.

- Try a floating and sinking experiment, gather some objects and have a guess (predict) what you think will happen. Then place them in the water and see what they do. There is some further information [here](#). You could even have a go at building your own boat. Try to use the key words: float and sink.

And the dish ran away with the spoon.

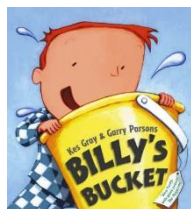
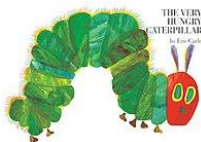
