Throughout the day, children will have a lot of fun with books

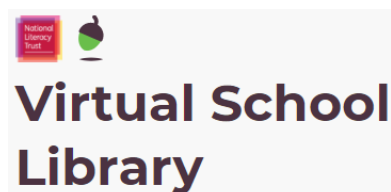
- An **art competition** to create a favourite book character/ scene from a book

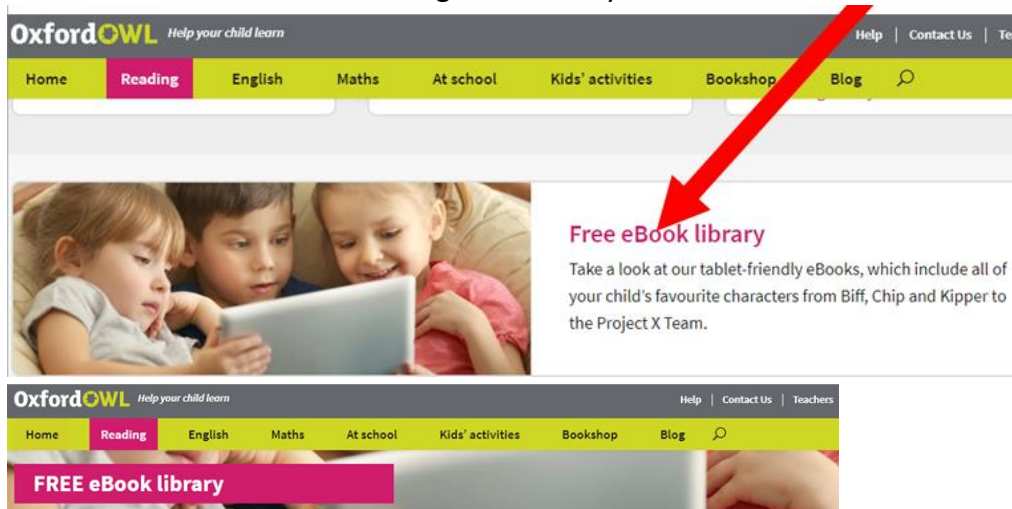
