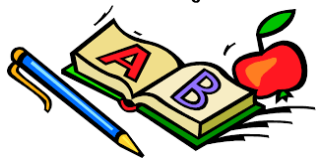


Dunstall Hill Primary School
EYFS Curriculum Overview - Autumn Term 1

Literacy



This half term your child will enjoy sharing in story time sessions, talking about books, and beginning to retell stories using puppets, props, and drawings.

The children will also mark make using a range of different materials.

Communication

Your child will begin to listen to others one to one or in small groups, join in with repeated refrains and anticipate key events and phrases in rhymes and stories.

We will begin to work on responding to simple instructions and retelling simple past events in the correct order.



Physical Development

We will be beginning to develop fine motor manipulation and control to use one handed tools, such as tweezers and pipettes. We will explore the outdoor environment, working on our gross motor skills including riding bikes, running, jumping and developing our special awareness.



Our topic this half term is 'All about me'.

We will be learning about different parts of our bodies, how we have changed since we were born, and looking at different people in our community and how they help us.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring our indoor and outdoor environment, focusing on the season of Autumn: how the leaves change colour and fall from the trees.

We will focus on how animals prepare for colder weather and hibernation and how the temperature changes as we get closer to Winter.



Mathematics

We will be focusing on numbers zero to five, representing these on our fingers. We will use actions such as clapping, stamping and jumping to count numbers to 10 and beyond. During group time we will focus on days of the week, months of the year and the weather,



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will be focusing on forming friendships with others. This will include being kind to others, sharing resources, and seeking support from adults when there is a problem. Children will be encouraged to explain their feelings and consider the feelings of others. We will also begin to learn our class and school rules.



Expressive Art and Design

We will begin by exploring paint on a large scale using the easels and exploring the primary colours: red, yellow, and blue.

We will also begin to explore percussion instruments and introduce our daily nursery songs.
