Literacy

This half term your child will be beginning to learn to read simple sounds using the Read Write Inc. programme. We will be encouraging your child to pronounce sounds purely and blend words using Fred talk. Your child will be learning to write their name and form letters correctly.

Physical Development

This half term your child will take part in PE every week. They will be learning to carry out basic movements with their bodies. The expectation is that the children **COME** to school dressed in school uniform and that they get changed into kit at school.

All about me

Theme - My family, my school, my environment, the people around me, people who help us. Our Topic this half term is 'All about me'. The children will learn about their bodies naming different body parts and learning how they move in a variety of ways.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring different celebrations and cultures. We will also be looking at the different seasons and changes within the environment.



Mathematics

Numbers -Verbally count to and back from 10 and then 20 when appropriate. Numbers within 5; including subitise (recognise quantities without counting) up to five. Number games, pattern games, ongoing mathematical provision for independent choice including numbers in sand tray, clocks, money etc.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term we will be focusing on making friends, learning to share and to become independent learners. Our classroom and school rules; how we all help to make our classroom a happy place to learn My Feelings; words I can use to describe how I am feeling. What I can do when I am angry or upset



Expressive Art and Design

This half term your child will be learning how to access a variety of materials to create their own work, looking at colours and textures. The focus will be on colour mixing. Exploring colour, painting with primary colours. Mixing secondary colours. A study of Miro and painting: portraits
