Talk for writing

Mathematics

We will be learning to count, read and write numbers 1-20. Also, we will be adding and

subtracting numbers.

The children will be learning their number bonds to 20 and learning to count forwards and backwards in ones.

During their maths lesson the children will take part in mental arithmetic on a weekly basis.
