## **Mathematics**

This term in Mathematics we will be focusing on Year 6 objectives which will include:

- Place value
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- 2D and 3D shape
- Measures
- Fractions

Alongside our daily Maths lessons, we will be focusing on a range of arithmetic skills including work on fractions, decimals and percentages.



# **Knowledge Subjects**

History – This term, children will build on their knowledge of Britain before the war and develop a deeper understanding of the causes and consequences of World War I on Britain, and the wider world. We will also be studying the Suffragette movement.

Art – Children will be introduced to the art of the Italian renaissance by looking at The School of Athens by Raphael and Vitruvian Man by Leonardo da Vinci. They will take inspiration from his work and develop their drawing skills.

#### Music

Children will learn to listen to and explore music for different purposes. This will include describing different pieces of music and expressing opinions about the music. They will learn to create repeated patterns with different musical instruments.

### Computing

Children will be learning how to code using multiple programming software such as Kodu and Scratch.



### Science

For Autumn 1, our Science topic is 'Animals including humans.' During this topic, pupils will learn about the human heart and lungs withing the circulatory system – how they work and how to keep them healthy. They will also take part in a range of practical activities and investigations, involving their heart rate and explore factors which affect it.

## RE

Our RE topic is based on charitable giving. We will be looking at, and comparing the beliefs of Christians and Muslims, focusing on the charities Christian Aid and Islamic Relief.
