This term the children will continue with learning gymnastics focusing on spinning on points and patches.

Mathematics

This term, the children are building on their knowledge from Autumn 1 and will be adding

and subtracting.



They will be introduced to shape, looking at 2D shapes and identifying the key features like how many faces, sides and vertices each shape has.

Then, the children will learn how to measure time, using chronological language. First, then, next...

During their maths lesson the children will take part in mental arithmetic on a weekly basis.

Knowledge Subjects

History – This term the children will focus on discovering history. They will learn what is the past. Understand family trees and the importance of family. The children will learn about archaeologists and what they do.

Art – In art, the children will be exploring lines. They begin with different styles of line drawing such as wavy, straight and spiral. They build on these skills by looking at artists like, Miro and Klee, creating their own versions of the artist's work.

Music

Rhythm in the way we walk and Banana Rap – The children will build on their knowledge from Autumn 1 and be introduced to different rap songs. Exploring, what instruments and vocals they can hear, learn the songs and then perform.

ICT

We will be learning about digital art. We will look at using different media to create patterns using technology.

Science

Animals and their needs - This term the children will explore animals and how they survive in the natural world. They will look at different classifications of animals like reptiles, amphibians and mammals. They will be encouraged to ask scientific questioning, discovering 'why' things happen.

PSHE

We will be learning about anti bullying and learning how to get on with everyone in the classroom environment and out on the playground.
