Children will focus on features of a diary and produce a diary entry of their own. They will also narrate a story based on the Christmas Truce of WW1, with a focus on dialogue and setting.

Knowledge Subjects

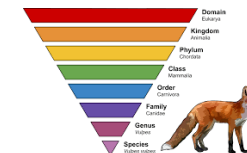
History – This term, children will build on their knowledge of The Suffragette Movement and democracy in the UK after World War 1.

Art – Children will be introduced into Renaissance architecture and sculpture. They will aim to develop their sketching skill and use of clay sculpture.

Geography – This term, children will study the issues affecting Britain today, such as Global Warming and Pollution.

Science

For Autumn 2, our science topic is 'Classification'. During this topic, pupils will learn about how plants and animals are categorised. They will develop an understanding of the different Kingdoms and study the famous scientist – Carl Linnaeus.



Mathematics

This term in Mathematics we will be focusing on Year 6 objectives which will include:

- Division
- Fractions
- Geometry

Alongside our daily Maths lessons, we will be focusing on a range of arithmetic skills including work on multiplication, division and fractions.



Music

Children will learn to listen to and explore music for different purposes. This will include describing different pieces of music and expressing opinions about the music. They will learn to create repeated patterns with different musical instruments.

Computing

Children will be learning how to code using multiple programming software such as Kodu and Scratch.

Our RE topic is based on charitable giving. We will be looking at, and comparing the beliefs of Christians and Muslims, focusing on the charities Christian Aid and Islamic Relief.
