We will be continuing to focus on what makes a good sentence using capital letters, word spaces and a full stop. We will continue to learn how to write for different kinds of purposes for example writing instructions, lists and captions. Your child will continue to learn new sounds and become fluent readers. We will continue to show increasing control over objects, and we will use simple tools to effect changes to materials. We will continue to show understanding of good practices with regards to exercise, sleeping and hygiene.



In the Garden

Our Topic this half term is ‘In the Garden.’ Within this topic, your child will be learning about different insects they find in the garden and how they grow. Children will learn about how to care for plants to help them grow. The children will learn the different parts of a plant. The children will learn about lifecycles of a plant and a butterfly. We will also start to look at seasons and changing seasons from winter to spring.



Understanding the World

We will continue to explore their outdoor area by exploring the woodlands area and explore changing seasons. They will also start to explore how to make early maps of their own environments and the local areas. To know that the weather can affect plants. Learn different stories of creation from different religions.

Mathematics

Numbers – This half term we will continue to focus on counting, recognising numbers to ten. They will then start to learn how to recognise number bonds to ten.

Numerical Patterns – we will learn about patterns; problem solving and learn lots of new vocabulary. we will continue our work on 2D and 3D shapes and talk about their properties.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will continue to learn how to express our feelings and start to think about the feelings of others. We will also be learning how to show resilience and carry on with new challenges. We will learn to be helpful at home and care for our world.



Expressive Art and Design

We will be continuing to access a variety of resources to create their own work learning to select different materials. They will learn how to adapt and change their designs and talk about the process of making their creations. Explore and create songs—using voices and classroom instruments.
