Knowledge Subjects

History – This term in History the children will be learning about Kings, Queens and Leaders. Within this topic they will learn about King John I and the Magna Carta. Henry III and the parliament and many more leaders.

Art – The children will be learning about style in art and narrative art. Through style in art, they will be exploring how art looks. Using specific techniques such as short brush strokes like Van Gogh and pointillism used by Seurat. Through narrative art, the children will explore the stories that paintings tell by looking at St George and the dragon.

Science – Taking care of the Earth!

The children will be exploring sustainability and ways they can protect the earth.

To begin with, the children will look at pollution and the impact it has on earth. They will look at logging and the result it has on forest areas.

Then, they will be introduced to renewable and non-renewable resources.

Lastly, they will learn about recycling and small but significant measures they can take to help the earth.



Mathematics

In maths the children will be learning to add and subtract within 20. They will make number bonds to 20 and they will find doubles. They will subtract by counting back and by finding the difference. They will recall and use related facts for addition and subtraction, as well as solving missing number problems.

Computing

This term the children will be learning about data and information and how to group data.



Music

This term the children will be listening to Bossa Nova! A style of samba music. They will compare it to different songs, identifying differences in the pulse, beat and instruments used.



PSHE

This term the children will be learning about online safety. Within this they will learn about who to contact if they feel that they are in danger online.

RE

In RE the children will learn about holy books and special stories within the Christian, Sikh - and Muslim faith.
