

English

In English this term, for our writing we will be looking at extracts from Holes for the purpose of non-fiction writing. We will focus on author choice of vocabulary and informative writing styles. Children also learn to perform poetry by heart.

Reading

In Reading this term, children will focus on developing their reading speed and fluency. They will use a range of reading strategies to help develop inference and comprehension skills.

PE

Net and Wall – Children will learn the techniques of volleyball and be taught the rules and regulations related to the game.

Mathematics

This term in Mathematics we will be focusing on Year 6 objectives which will include:

- Angles
- Geometry - circles
- Area and perimeter
- Geometry – 2D/3D shapes and their properties.

Alongside our daily Maths lessons, we will be focusing on a range of arithmetic skills including fractions, decimals and percentages and the four main operations.
