EYFS	Children in early years will begin to develop their knowledge of spatial sense by exploring their world and thinking about the location of the school, how they travel through their local environment and what landmarks are around them. Children learn how humans have influenced the world when they learn about their community, transport and travel from the past through to the present. In our unit about growing and changing, children learn about farming and where we source the food that we eat. They will also begin to explore the idea that England is part of the wider world and identify countries on a world map. Staff also provide opportunities for children to discover more about their immediate natural environment through activities such as Welly Wednesdays and Forest Fridays.
