

# Home School Agreement Dunstall Hill Primary School



By working together we can help your child be the best that they can be.

#### The school will aim to:

- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum;
- Treat every child as a unique individual;
- Build on the school Core Values (Determination, Having Respect, Positivity and Success)
- Develop independence, resilience and self-confidence;
- Keep parents/carers informed about school activities;
- Inform parents/carers of any serious concerns affecting their child's work or behaviour;
- Inform parents/carers about their child's progress at termly meetings and provide an annual written report;
- Encourage mutual respect between pupils and adults;
- Provide appropriate home activities to support learning;
- Care for the safety and wellbeing of each child;
- Create lifelong learners;
- Have high expectations for all and ensure that all children achieve their best;
- Provide children with a breadth of experiences, knowledge and understanding of the possibilities that are available to them in the world.

## The family will aim to:

- Ensure their child attends school every day;
- Ensure that their child arrives at and is collected from school on time;
- Contact the school first thing in the morning to explain any absences;
- Inform the school of any concerns, problems or medical needs that might affect their child;
- Inform school of any changes to information (address, telephone number, email address etc.);
- Support the school's behaviour policy;
- Support home learning activities and make sure any materials that are borrowed from school are returned in order to avoid charges;
- Monitor their child's use of the internet and social networking sites, ensuring their child adhere to the age restrictions and advice given on e-safety;
- Attend Parent Consultations and structured meetings to discuss their child's progress;
- Ensure their child is dressed appropriately for school, adhering to the uniform policy, including the correct shoes (no trainers), PE kits and jewellery (only a pair of stud earnings);
- Encourage mutual respect between pupils by demonstrating appropriate behaviour and language towards staff, children and other parents;
- Build positive working relationships with all school staff.

#### The child will:

- Follow the school rules and adhere to the school Core Values;
- Always try and do their best;
- Consider the feelings of peers and all staff;
- Wear the full school uniform and PE kit with pride and be a school ambassador whenever wearing it;
- Always tell a member of staff about my problems/ concerns that stop them from feeling happy and safe;
- Always respect themselves, peers and adults;
- Respect the school's property, their own and the property of my peers;
- Maintain positive attitudes in school and conduct themselves in an appropriate and sensible manner.

## Together we will:

Provide a place to grow in a caring environment for learning, in which all children can develop confidence as an individual and as a member of the wider community.

### Parent/ Carer Code of Conduct

All visitors are expected to treat staff, children and other parents in a respectful way when on any of our sites. Any threatening, abusive or violent behaviour against any staff member or child is taken extremely seriously. Examples of such behaviour are below:

- Shouting at or intimidating staff;
- Raised voices;
- Rallying other parents to become involved in intimidating behaviour;
- Publically voicing unsubstantiated claims about staff, children, school or PHMAT;
- Swearing;
- Using racist, sexist or homophobic terms;
- Using violence;
- Taking alcohol or drugs on the premises;
- Wilful damage to school property;
- Theft;
- Threats or threatening behaviour;
- Posting on social media sites about school or staff (whether they are named or unnamed).

This list is not an exhaustive list but seeks to provide illustrations of such behaviour that is not acceptable in our schools. Anyone behaving this way will be asked to leave the premises and the Police will be called if verbal or physical harassment occurs. If necessary action will be taken to ban anyone behaving such a way from the school grounds.
